

India asks Oman to cut duties on chemical products

New Delhi, India has requested Oman to reduce customs tariff on Indian chemical products, which would provide better market access to them in the Gulf nation, India's Commerce Ministry said on Tuesday.

A statement issued at the end of the 8th session of the India-Oman Joint Commission meeting (July 16-17) in Muscat also said that both sides agreed to obtain their respective internal approvals for early finalisation of a bilateral Double Taxation Avoidance Agreement (DTAA).

"India requested for reduction in customs tariff on Indian chemical products exported to Oman, which is about 5 per cent. The reduction of tariff on items such as dyes, inorganic and organic chemicals, agrochemicals and cosmetics would provide better market access," it said.

The India-Oman Bilateral Investment Treaty (BIT) is under revision, it noted.

Visiting Commerce Minister Suresh Prabhu headed the Indian delegation to Muscat. The Omani team was led by Ali bin Masoud Al Sunaidi.

India informed Oman that since the Urea Off Take Agreement (UOTA) was valid till 2020, talks should start for extension of UOTA beyond 2020 and up to 2025. The Omani side said that it was willing to consider extension of the existing UOTA beyond 2020, the statement said.

India is also proposing continuation of existing prices for the extension of

validity of the Gas Supply Agreement (GSA).

According to the ministry, a proposal for an India-Oman joint venture for setting up the world's largest waste-to-energy plant in India is under consideration.

"This joint venture will generate 200 gigawatt energy per year by processing around 9,000 tonnes of municipal solid waste per year. India informed that the government is awaiting the response from Oman," it said.

India and Oman also agreed to cooperate in the field of tourism. The other areas of cooperation include mines, telecom and IT, space, health and education.

India-Oman trade has increased to \$6.7 billion in 2017-18 from \$4.13 billion in 2014-15.

India's passenger aircraft fleet will double to 1,100 by 2027: Study

Mumbai, International aircraft leasing company Avolon has forecasted that India's current passenger jet fleet will double to almost 1,100 by 2027.

According to the company's white paper "India, a 21st Century Powerhouse", the total value of aircraft to be delivered over the coming ten years in India, at the current list prices, is projected to be \$60 billion.

Currently, airlines in India operate almost 600 passenger aircraft which comprise 75 per cent of narrowbody, 11 per cent of widebody and 14 per cent

has averaged 15 per cent since 2012.

"While economic and structural barriers remain, India offers an attractive long-term growth market with opportunities in the region significantly outweighing the challenges," said Dick Forsberg, Avolon's Head of Strategy and author of the study.

"However, the international aviation sector in India has been under-developed and, in order to achieve its full potential to support long-term economic growth, trade and tourism, it is imperative that it receives renewed focus and investment."

Google Doodle honours Georges Lemaitre's Big Bang theory

New Delhi, Google on Tuesday dedicated an animated Doodle to Belgian cosmologist Georges Lemaitre who in 1927 propounded the Big Bang theory when he theorised that the universe began as a single point and expanded to become as big as it is now.

Lemaitre's thesis was based on calculations derived from Albert Einstein's Theory of General Relativity, but Einstein was initially not impressed with Lemaitre's work.

"Your calculations are correct, but your physics is atrocious," Einstein said, two years before changing his

mind. For his contribution to enhancing the understanding of the universe, Lemaitre received in 1934 the prestigious Francqui prize, the highest scientific accolade in Belgium -- and one of his nominators was Einstein.

The Google Doodle on Tuesday that marks Lemaitre's 124th birth anniversary depicts the cosmologist within the constantly expanding universe that he first envisioned, surrounded by galaxies expanding outward just as he said they would.

Born on July 17, 1894 in the Belgian city of Charleroi, Lemaitre wore many hats in his lifetime. He served the Belgian Army during World

War I. He entered a seminary after the war and was ordained a Catholic priest in 1923.

He studied physics at the University of Cambridge, Harvard University and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).

Lemaitre's 1927 paper theorising that the universe was expanding was soon substantiated by Edwin Hubble's observations, which were published in 1929.

Lemaitre accurately estimated the numerical value that astronomers would come to call the Hubble constant, a unit of measurement that describes the universe's rate of expansion.

Finance panel assures on Bengal's debt restructuring demand

Kolkata, The 15th Finance Commission on Tuesday assured West Bengal that it would "explore all possible ways" to meet the state's demand for restructuring the debt.

"I think the state brought out very forcefully the need for the Finance Commission to look at the legacy issue of the debt. The commission has taken note of the state government's demand and will explore all possible ways within our mandate," panel Chairman N.K. Singh said.

During its three-day

visit, the commission met representatives of political parties, urban local bodies, panchayats and state officials apart from Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee and Finance Minister Amit Mitra. "The Chief Minister made detailed observations, which were followed by presentations on the state finances," Singh said.

Referring to the state's representation, the commission Chair said that Bengal had urged for a look at the innovative ways through which this large debt overhang could be redressed in

a manner that it "does not become a permanent drag on the state economy".

He also said that Bengal's economy in the last few years had made "enormous progress" in terms of key macroeconomic parameters such as GDP growth, debt management, increase in own tax revenue and innovative ways of financing.

He said that the state had made significant strides in many human developmental indices, including education and health. Speaking on the state's opposition to the commission's terms of reference in regards to the use of 2011 census for determining the share of states, Singh said that the panel had nothing to do with the issue since the terms were stipulated by the President of India. The Chief Minister said that the meeting between the Finance Commission and state officials was "good".

NCLT approves Liberty House's plan for acquiring Adhunik Metaliks

Kolkata, The Kolkata bench of the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) on Tuesday approved the resolution plan of the Britain-based Liberty House for acquiring debt-laden steelmaker Adhunik Metaliks under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC).

The lenders' committee had approved the plan on the last day of the extended timeline for the corporate insolvency resolution process (CIRP) for the steel maker recently.

"...the revival plan of the company in accordance with the approved resolution plan shall come into force with immediate effect," the bench said.

There were only two

resolution applicants for debt-laden steel manufacturer Liberty House, part of Sanjeev Gupta-led GFG Alliance, and Maharashtra Seamless of the D.P. Jindal Group.

The Sanjeev Gupta-led metals and industrial company was identified as the highest bidder (H1) by the creditors, while the plan of Maharashtra Seamless was rejected due to the offering being of lesser value than the liquidation value of the company.

Notably, the bankruptcy proceedings against Adhunik Metaliks, Zion Steel and another Adhunik Group company, Orissa Manganes & Minerals Ltd (OMML) were admitted by the Kolkata bench of NCLT in

August last year.

Lenders to the insolvent company are State Bank of India, Punjab National Bank, UCO Bank, Allahabad Bank, Punjab & Sind Bank, Bank of Baroda, Corporation Bank, ICICI Bank, IFCI and SRE Infrastructure Finance, among others.

In this case, as many as 18 financial creditors submitted claims worth over Rs 5,380 crore, while claims over Rs 5,370 crore were admitted.

Airbus appoints new India head for its helicopters business

New Delhi, Aerospace major Airbus on Tuesday said it has appointed Ashish Saraf as Head of the helicopter division of Airbus India. According to the aerospace major, Saraf, whose appointment is effective July 1, 2018 takes over from Xavier Hay, who leaves India after six years to take over new responsibilities. "Saraf joins Airbus Helicopters at a time when the company is competing on several military helicopter projects that would reinforce and enhance the local aerospace and defence industrial ecosystem," the aerospace major said in a statement. "Airbus Helicopters is a market leader in the Indian civil and parapublic market with close to 100 helicopters in operation today, and it is helping to develop new market segments such as Helicopter Emergency Medical Services (HEMS) and heli-tourism in the country." As per the statement, since 2015, Saraf had been serving as Vice President - Industry Development, Strategic Partnerships and Offsets at Airbus India, focusing on 'Make in India' initiatives aimed at enhancing the company's industrial footprint. Before joining Airbus, Saraf was the India Head of the Tata Sikorsky joint venture and led Sikorsky's industrialisation and strategic partnerships.

Government increases maximum load capacity for trucks

New Delhi, The government has decided to increase the maximum load carrying capacity of all new heavy vehicles by 20-25 per cent, Road Transport and Highway Minister Nitin Gadkari said on Tuesday. He said this would bring down the logistic cost in the country by 2 per cent and will help in increasing the "ease of doing business". "Logistic cost in India is 16 to 18 per cent of the GDP whereas it is 8 to 10 per cent in developed countries. This decision will reduce transport cost by 2 per cent and will revolutionise the transport sector," Gadkari told reporters here. He added that norms for axle load were last notified in 1983 and there has been no change over the last 35 years despite vast improvements in technology.
