AAP flays BJP for doing politics on anti-dengue drive

New Delhi, There should be no politics on the anti-dengue drive and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) should also join the initiative, said Sanjay Singh, Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) member of the Rajya Sabha, here on Monday. By not taking part in the campaign for political gains, the BJP was playing with the life of Delhi residents, he said. Singh said the Arvind Kejriwal's initiative had received support from citizens as well as celebrities. "However, the BJP has opposed to this initiative," he said. "Not a single BJP leader came out to take part in the initiative to make Delhi dengue free. When the Prime Minister launched the Swachh Bharat campaign, Kejriwal joined it and organised others to be part of it," the AAP MP said. Cautioning the BJP, the AAP leader said, "Dengue mosquitoes don't differentiate people by their political hues."

UP cabinet approves interim relief to victims of mob lynching

Lucknow, The Uttar Pradesh cabinet approved 11 proposals in its meeting on Tuesday presided over by Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, including monetary compensation to victims of various crimes including mob lynching, rape and acid attack. The proposal is in compliance with the Supreme Court judgement of July 17, 2018, where it said that victims of various crimes, including mob lynching, rape and acid attack, will be granted 25 per cent interim compensation at the level of District Magistrate. Earlier Subordinate Services Selection Commission used to do selection on Group A and B posts, which will now be done by the Public Service Selection Commission. The age for application has also been increased from 35 years to 40 years, the minister said. Apart from this, the cabinet also approved amendment in UP Agricultural Services Rules. Earlier applicants only with the degree of B.Sc. (Agriculture) could apply for UP Agriculture Services but now applicants who have B.Sc degree in Forestry, Horticulture, Home Science and Community Science will be also eligible to apply.

Court asks IT firms to respond to PIL about violations

Hyderabad, Telangana High Court has directed three IT companies, including Accenture and Cognizant, to file their response on a Public Interest Litigation (PIL) with regard to alleged exploitation of employees in violation of the Shops & Establishments Act. The court asked Accenture, Cognizant and Casper Technologies to submit their responses to the court within four weeks. The PIL has been filed by FAN Against Corruption, a Hyderabad-based NGO.

Karnataka, Goa CMs to meet

Mhadei issue, Cong warns Sawant

Panaji, While Karnataka Chief Minister B.S. Yediyurappa said on Tuesday he was scheduled to meet Goa Chief Minister Pramod Sawant in a few days for a negotiated settlement over the Mhadei river water sharing issue, the Congress again warned the BJP-led coalition government in Goa against any such talks. "The Chief Minister should not take false course of fishing in troubled waters. These are all backward march which sacrifice Goa's interests at the altar of Karnataka," Congress spokesperson Trajano Mello said, here on Tuesday. Earlier in the day, Yediyurappa said in Bengaluru he had sought an appointment with Sawant to discuss the Mhadei issue and could visit Goa on September 16 or 17 to hold talks. On Monday, Union Minister for Coal and Mines Pralhad Joshi had said that the Chief Ministers of both states should discuss and negotiate a mutually agreeable settlement rather than depending upon the Mhadei river water dispute tribunal or a Supreme Court order. "I can only suggest at this moment, that the Chief Minister sit and talk to try resolve the issue. The matter has been to the tribunal and it has given its award. But a negotiated settlement will be a better settlement," Joshi said.

Sonia okays poll, campaign panels for Haryana elections

New Delhi, Congress interim President Sonia Gandhi on Tuesday approved a 28-member election committee and 50-member campaign committee for the party's Haryana unit, ahead of the state assembly polls due later this year. Congress Legislature Party (CLP) leader Kiran Chaudhary, Kuldeep Bishnoi, Captain Ajay Yadav, H.S. Chatta, Phoolchand Mallana and Mahendra Pratap Singh are also part of the committee, AICC general secretary K. C. Venugopal said. The Congress is looking for a comeback in Haryana elections and seeks to oust the ruling BJP which has been in power for the last five years. A special session of UP's bi-cameral legislature comprising the Vidhan Sabha and Vidhan Parishad will be convened on October 2 to mark the 150th birth anniversary of Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi.

Pakistan urges UN SG to intervene on Kashmir issue

New York, Pakistan's Envoy to United Nations Maleeha Lodi said that she met UN Secretary-General António Guterres and urged him to intervene in the Kashmir issue. Lodi on Tuesday tweeted: "In my meeting with UNSG Antonio Guterres I told him that the grave political & humanitarian crisis, which has unfolded after India's illegal annexation of occupied Jammu & Kashmir last month, poses a threat to international peace and security." She said that it has been 36 days since the ban was put on place in Kashmir and it has "triggered a human crisis there." Uneasy over the abrogation of Article 370 in Kashmir by India, the Pakistan envoy told Guterres that India's steps have triggered a threat to the global peace.

Another BJP leader shot dead in UP

Lucknow, Following a series of similar attacks, yet another BJP leader was shot dead in Uttar Pradesh on Wednesday, this time in Basti district, the police said. This comes a day after a BJP leader was shot dead in Saharanpur district on Tuesday. Chaudhary Yashpal Singh, who was shot dead on Tuesday by bike-borne unidentified assailants in Talhedi Khurd near his Mirapur village in Deoband in Saharanpur district.

Chandrayaan 2 is most trending hashtag in India

New Delhi, India's ambitious lunar mission - Chandrayaan 2 - has become the country's most trending hashtag on social media platforms such as Twitter, with 67,554 tweets in between September 1-9, a new study revealed on Tuesday. SEMrush, the online visibility management company recently conducted the study on the keyword Vikram in the period between September 1-9, which showed that Twitter is buzzing with Chandrayaan 2, the lander Vikram and ISRO. According to the study, there have been 2,39,109 tweets dedicated to the mission. "India is showing great interest in the initiatives taken by ISRO. People are using Twitter as a platform to share their views on the mission. It is overwhelming to see that despite the mission's result, people are being positive and neutral in their approach," said Fernando Angulo, Head of Communications, SEMrush.

Only 1 in 5 Indians go for regular eye checkups: Study

New Delhi, New research findings have revealed a significant increase in the number of Indians suffering from poor eyesight, with only one in five adults going for regular eye checkups and an alarming 84 per cent admitting to not following their doctor's advice for eye care. The study by Signify, formerly known as Philips Lighting, covered 1,000 Indian adults and 300 ophthalmologists across top 10 Indian cities. While 65 per cent adults claimed that a healthy eyesight is a key priority for their well-being, very few people take steps to actively maintain their vision. Signify said in a statement on Wednesday. The study also highlighted that Indians spend over 14 hours daily indoors under artificial light, and the quality of lighting becomes an important factor in maintaining eye health. As per the research, ophthalmologists state that 3 in 4 Indians complain of eye strain after 10 hours of daily screen time, and young adults in the age group of 20-35 years frequently report eye strain, redness and irritation in the eyes. According to Indian ophthalmologists, many factors can lead to deterioration in eyesight and eye discomfort. Bad lighting (64 per cent), a poor lifestyle (92 per cent) and other health issues like diabetes (82 per cent) were indicated as leading factors by ophthalmologists in the country. Almost 20 per cent of respondents reported that lighting can play an important role in maintaining eye health and that flicker, too much brightness and incorrect positioning of the light source can hurt eyes in the long term.

Will retire Pawar from public life: Maha BJP chief

Kolhapur (Maharashtra), The Bharatiya Janata Party state President Chandrakant Patil on Wednesday vowed to ensure "Nationalist Congress Party chief Sharad Pawar" retires from political and social life "after the October 21 Maharashtra assembly elections." He will make sure he (Sharad Pawar) permanently retires from social and political arena once the assembly polls results are out," thundered Patil at an election rally in Kolhapur. Taking a swipe at the spat of defections and desertions from the beleaguered NCP in recent months to the ruling cabinet, Patil said that it would not be surprising if the gen-next of the influential Pawar family switch over to the BJP in the coming times. Interestingly, the 72-year-old Sharad Pawar's grand-nephew Rohit Pawar is contesting from Karjat-Jamkhed Assembly seat in Ahmednagar district this time while Ajit Pawar's son Parth suffered an embarrassing defeat in the Mayal Lok Sabha elections from Shiv Sena's Shrirang Barne. The BJP chief's assertions were in sync with the party strategy in which almost all top leaders including Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis have repeatedly vowed to "wipe out the influence of the Pawars in Maharashtra politics by 2024." Unfazed by the targeting of the Pawar clan, the NCP with its ally Congress and other parties, gave promised to dislodge the BJP-Sena government from power when the election results are announced on October 24. Patil is contesting his maiden Assembly election from Kolthrud (Pune) and was campaigning for the ally Shiv Sena ministerial portfolio of Ashitkar who is seeking re-election from Radhanagari in Kolhapur.

Centre grants 5,300 refugee families from Pak Rs 5.5 lakh each

New Delhi, Union Environment Minister Prakash Javadekar on Wednesday said the Centre will give financial support of Rs 5.5 lakh each to 5,300 refugee families that had migrated to Jammu and Kashmir from Pakistan. Briefing mediapersons following a cabinet meeting, Javadekar said: "The first lot of refugees came to India after Partition and the second lot came after the accession of Kashmir to India, and then many refugees from Pakistan occupied Kashmir (PoK). The Prime Minister in 2016, had already announced a package of Rs 5.5 lakh to the refugees families." Explaining the delay in providing the financial assistance to these families, Javadekar said they had initially opted to move outside the state of Jammu and Kashmir, but later returned, and finally settled in the state. The rehabilitation package was approved by the Cabinet in November 2016. He said that many families had initially gone to Kashmir, but later they settled in other states. "Injustice was done with them, but now we have brought justice for them. It will be welcomed in Kashmir. 5,300 families will gain the financial assistance of Rs 5.5 lakh. A historical wrong has been corrected," Javadekar said.

Insurance digital premiums a \$37 bn market by 2025: JM Fin

New Delhi, Online insurance sales for new business, which are in a nascent stage in the country are fast catching up and are likely to grow at a CAGR of 13 per cent to become a \$37 billion market by 2025, according to a report released by JM Financial. The report said the market size of online insurance business in India is currently pegged at Rs 1.1 trillion (\$15 billion). While a major proportion of online sales will come from life insurance renewal premiums (estimated at 94 per cent in FY19), digital sales of non-life insurance policies are gaining traction and may impact volumes more than the value, as ticket sizes are relatively small, the report points out. Interestingly, the share of life insurance (renewal) premium in the digital premium space will come down to 85 per cent in FY25 from 94 per cent in FY19 while non-life insurance will go up to 5 per cent from 3 per cent, life - new business premium (NB) to 4 per cent from 3 per cent, others and health insurance will go up to 3 per cent and 2 per cent, respectively

Govt extends Aadhaar seeding date for PM-Kisan scheme

New Delhi, The Central government on Wednesday extended till November 30 the mandatory requirement of Aadhaar seeding to avail the income support of Rs 6,000 per year under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Scheme. The decision was taken in a Cabinet meeting chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The Cabinet has decided to relax till November 30, the mandatory requirement of Aadhaar seeding for release of benefits under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi after August 1st information and Broadcasting Minister Prakash Javadekar told the media here. Known as "PM KISAN", the Central government-funded scheme was launched in December 2018. Income support of Rs 6,000 per year in three equal instalments was being provided to small and marginal farmer families having combined land-holding or ownership of up to 2 hectares. Javadekar said over seven crore farmers are getting the funds directly transferred to their bank accounts.
